Autumn 2 – How do we celebrate?

Please choose 1 of the following projects to complete linked to our topic this term: 'How do we celebrate?' In school, we will be learning about Autumn, Halloween, Diwali, Bonfire Night, Hanukkah and Christmas.

Option 1: Create a Bonfire Night Collage.

You could use coloured tissue paper, glitter or natural found objects to create your picture.

Whilst you're making your picture, you could discuss:

What can you hear on Bonfire Night?

What can you see on Bonfire Night?

What can you smell on Bonfire Night?

What can you taste on Bonfire Night?

(You may wish to discuss safety elements like the importance of staying safe, warm drinks, and sparklers).





Option 2: Autumnal Walk

Go on an Autumnal walk with your family and collect some Autumnal objects.

Whilst on your walk, discuss:

What can you hear?

What can you see?

What can you smell?

Use the items you collected to make a collage.

What colours and patterns can you see?

Send a picture on Seesaw of your finished artwork or bring it in to class.





Key vocab:

Autumn, celebrate, notice, change, fall, Halloween, Christmas, Diwali, Bonfire Night, Hanukkah.



Option 3: Christmas List

Can you make a list to send to Father Christmas?

You can cut out pictures from magazines or catalogues to create your list.

Some children might chose to make marks using their lines and circle shapes.

Some might use letters from their name and some children might use their sound talk to help them to break up the sound before writing them.
